


Heysham Attractions



Heysham is well worth a visit having one of the finest Anglo-Viking sites in the Northwest. Its cliff-top setting provides superb views over the Bay from the headland near the romantic ruins of St Patrick's chapel down to the snuggling cottages many dating back to the 17th Century. Enjoy afternoon tea in the village cafes or dine in the beer gardens of the 16th century village pub. Heysham's curiosities such as the famous nettle beer or the novel brass beam-weighing machine add to the immense charm of this village.
